**Technical Skills**: Use of ICT, Programming languages, Development of e content related to teaching profession.

Soft Skills: Communication, teamwork, problem-solving, critical thinking, and time management.

Content Knowledge: Work on content knowledge and go through the NCERT textbooks.

Adarsh encouraged students to actively participate in workshops, hackathons, and projects to hone their skills and build a strong portfolio. He also highlighted the importance of online learning platforms like Coursera and Udemy for acquiring additional skills and certifications.

**Akriti on Stepping Out of Your Comfort Zone:** Akriti took the discussion beyond technical skills, urging students not to limit themselves geographically during campus placement. She shared her personal experience, expressing regret over her decision to decline a placement offer due to its location outside her hometown. Network actively: Attend industry events, connect with alumni, and build professional relationships.


**Be open to new experiences**: Stepping outside your comfort zone can lead to unexpected opportunities and personal growth.
